

## **\*ENOUGH OF THE NPP SABOTAGE - CHRIS ETSEY AZAODI\***

About two months ago my patience on the inaction of my own party men run out and I had no choice but to bodily and loudly announce my disappointment and displeasure about how my own party chairman \*Freddie Blay\* with the connivance of the police are twisting my arm in a deal that I have invested so heavily in (the so called 1 Constituency 1 bus policy) which won Chairman Blay his position.

I felt so betrayed and frustrated and asked my Lawyers to present my disappointment to the Service and issue an ultimatum (copy of letter attached) on which expiry I would be forced to take my own steps in retrieving the vehicles. The ultimatum elapsed with not even a response from the police.

I am by this, serving notice to all concerned, that I have (with the support of all Citizens of Tongu) decided to block all those vehicles plying the roads, especially the Accra- Aflao and Accra-Ho roads on \*Saturday 30th May 2020\*.

Enough of the disrespect and undermining of people of the Volta Region by Mr Blay who has consistently disrespected the people of the Volta Region including our most revered chiefs.

Let posterity judge us all for our actions and inactions.

**RE: REPORT OF MR CHRIS ETSE AZAWODI, CEO  
ON BEHALF OF KELLIOT ROYAL MOTORS LTD  
DATED 27<sup>TH</sup> JAN, 2020**

1. We act as Solicitors for Messrs **KELLIOT ROYAL MOTORS LTD**, acting per their Chief Executive Officer (CEO) **Mr. CHRIS ETSE AZAWODI** of Accra and we write to you on their firm instructions
2. Our Clients instruct us that acting per their CEO (Mr. Chris Etse Azawodi), they had lodged a fraud case at your Department and personally with you on 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 against the management of Universal Merchant Bank Ltd (UMB).
3. The subject matter of the complaint is basically the stealing/conversion of their One Hundred (100) Toyota Hiace buses which they imported into the country. These vehicles on arrival were fraudulently/or converted and registered in the Bank's name with another individual, thereby depriving our Clients of the ownership, use of and interest therein.

Our further instructions are that though you were supplied with cogent and sufficient evidence that these buses are truly and fraudulently registered in the UMB's name with another personality, you and your officers had intentionally refused/neglected to conduct ANY investigations with the view of retrieving and restoring the vehicles into the name of the original and legal owners – **KELLIOT ROYAL MOTORS LTD** whose CEO is **Mr. CHRIS ETSE AZAWODI**.

5. In his earlier complaint to you dated 27<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 my Clients furnished you with all the **CHASSIS NUMBERS** of the buses and accompanied same with the necessary customs valid documents (Bill of lading) which permitted the vehicles to be imported into the country in the name of our Clients.
6. It is instructive to note that my Clients secured a loan of \$3.4m from the UMD Ltd for the purposes of the importation of the buses for which amount they used cash collateral of \$3m to import the buses in order to sell same to other bodies. The necessary agreement were attached to the complaint made to you.  
As at today, One Hundred (100) of the buses that arrived successfully in Ghana have been fraudulently and misappropriated into the name of UMB Ltd, whilst UMB is still holding onto my Clients' cash of \$3m
7. Our instructions are to urge on you to cause the buses bearing the Chassis numbers to be impounded. These buses are plying the routes and roaming the streets of Ghana without any reference or advantage to our Clients who are the legitimate owners. Our Clients per our instructions expect a firm action on this matter from your Department within the next **SEVENTY – TWO** hours, failing which my Clients will have no alternative than to seek redress in any form (legal) they deem fit.
8. Respectfully, our Clients are law abiding citizens who need protection from the law which is administered by the state and the service provided by the Police Service of Ghana but they have for all these period been unfairly treated but do not deem it necessary to resort to self-help in this matter. Indeed the action of your Department – Ghana Police Service – should not ever be a factor in promoting citizens' rights violations.

9. Whilst looking forward for your positive action in this matter.
